**Department of Public Works** provides snow removal on all public streets, branch pick up during the summer months and leaf pick up in autumn months. These services are free of charge to residents.

### Economic Development

**Committee** Meetings are held on the 1st Thursday of each month at 7:00pm at the Municipal Building

**Village Stickers** go on sale June 1st each year. Penalties are applied to all stickers purchased after July 1st. Your vehicle registration will be required. Fees are as follows

Passenger Vehicles	\$10.00
Motorcycles	\$ 7.50
Trucks	\$15.00
Seniors/Handicapped	\$ 1.00

(1 senior or handicapped sticker per household)

**Dogs** must be licensed. A dog license is \$5.00 with current rabies certificate. After July 1st penalties apply. Not more than two dogs per household. Dogs must be confined or on a leash. No dogs at schools or parks. If you walk your dog you are responsible for cleaning up after them.

**Bicycles** may be registered at the Police Department. Fee is \$1.00 per bicycle.

**Garage Sale Permits** are \$5.00 and are available at the Village Hall. The permit is good for two consecutive days.

**Building Permits** are required for new construction, alterations, repairs, electrical, plumbing, driveways, sidewalks, fences and installation of pools. B.O.C.A.

Building codes must be followed. Permits must be obtained before work is started.

Application process may take up to 72 hours.

**Contractors** must be licensed with the Village of Steger. If the homeowner chooses to "do it yourself" a deposit will be required to ensure that the work is completed properly, safely and without damage to village or neighbors property.
